White Balance Calibration Chart

Nikon D50 Instructions, WB Preset Mode

- 1. Hold the **WB button on the camera back** panel and **spin the command dial until the PRE** White Balance choice appears on the LCD Control Panel
- 2. Release the WB Button, and then **press it again until a blinking PRE icon appears in the control panel** space and the viewfinder where the numbers of exposures normally are shown.
- 3. With the PRE icon still flashing, **point the camera to fill the frame with this chart**, or any neutral grayscale surface and **press the shutter release button completely**. For best results us an 18% gray diffusion panel as the target. No photograph will be taken and accurate results are obtained even if the camera is not in focus. The camera will **display "Good"** in the LCD control panel (and Gd in the viewfinder) if it successfully measured the white balance of the object, or noGd in both locations if the measurement is unsuccessful.
- 4. If the measurement didn't work out (Good does not appear) then repeat steps 1 through 3.
